### PALEY ROTHMAN'S GLENN COOPER NAMED FELLOW OF AMERICAN COLLEGE OF TRIAL LAWYERS

**BETHESDA, MD**—Glenn M. Cooper, one of the most highly respected trial lawyers in Montgomery County and the entire Washington, D.C. area, has been admitted as a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers (ACTL), one of the premier legal associations in America.

Cooper, who chairs Paley Rothman's Litigation Section, and co-chairs the firm's Commercial Litigation, Appellate and Family Law Practice Groups, was inducted at the college's Annual Meeting held recently in Tucson, Arizona. The ACTL is comprised of experienced attorneys (minimum of 15 years in practice) from the U.S. and Canada, and Fellowship is extended **by invitation only to those trial lawyers who have maintained the highest standards of ethical conduct, professionalism, civility and collegiality.** The organization's goal is to improve and elevate the art of advocacy, standards of trial practice, the administration of justice and the ethics of the trial professions. ACTL membership is limited to no more than 1 per cent of the total lawyer population of any state or province.

A past president of both the Bar Association of Montgomery County and the Maryland Bar Foundation-Montgomery County, Cooper regularly appears before federal and state courts at both the trial and appellate levels, and before arbitration panels and professional disciplinary boards. He has briefed and argued a significant number of civil cases in Maryland's highest court, the Court of Appeals, which only accepts cases that involve issues of public importance. He is a four-time recipient of *Washingtonian's* "Top Lawyers" designation, and has been named on multiple occasions in "Best Lawyers in America" and "Super Lawyers."

Cooper graduated *with honors* from the University of Maryland School of Law after earning his undergraduate degree at the same university. He is a member of the Maryland and District of Columbia bars who lives in Potomac, Md.
